The Missing Sisters Walk 2010 will take place in July 2010. This annual walk/run has been an ongoing journey since 2005. The walk originated to raise awareness regarding the disappearance of Daleen Kay Bosse (Muskego), a 25 year old Aboriginal mother who went missing on the evening of May 18th 2004. After four years of carrying the burden of hope and not knowing where their daughter was, Daleen's remains were found near Saskatoon. The Muskego family has chosen to continue the run in her memory and carry on the mission of raising awareness that all life matters, particularly our mothers, sisters, and daughters who remain missing.

The Missing Sisters Walk creates awareness of the 500+ Native women who have been missing and/or murdered from across Canada over the past 30 years. Today, public awareness regarding this issue remains virtually non-existent. The run continues to raise awareness to the issue so that lives might be saved creating a space for justice and healing to begin. Being active in walks and rallies show that we care as a society to take action concerning violence against women. For true change to take place we must work as a community allowing our voices to be heard in harmony together inspiring social change.

This year the 320 kilometer journey will take place from Saskatoon to Onion Lake Cree Nation. Numerous runners, walkers, and many invaluable support volunteers participate in this run annually. To help cover the costs of food, water and fuel for the 5-day walk/run there is a steak night fundraiser planned at Mulberry's in Saskatoon on June 18, 2010.
